Memorials are required to be designed and installed using an accredited fixing method designed to British Standard 8415, and the construction, dowels and fixings being in accordance with the National Association of Memorial Masons Code of Working Practice. Memorials are additionally to be inscribed with the grave number to aid identification. The Parish Council does not permit memorials to be erected until 12 months have elapsed from the date of burial to allow time for ground settlement.	Following installation, confirmation is required of the date and method of installation, supplying testing certificated evidencing that this memorial and any component ground anchor and lock down systems have been designed to meet BS8415, and that it has been installed in such a way that it will remain safe for at least 30 years. A copy of your guarantee being issued to the grave owner should be lodged with the Parish Council; 30 years is recommended, the minimum period is 10 years.
