



UPDATE: CREATION OF A NEW ECOLOGY HABITAT

What are we doing?

We sent you information in December telling you about a new habitat site that we are creating in the area shown in yellow on the map below. This new site will be part of the 'green corridor' of connected wildlife habitats alongside the future railway.

How are we doing?

The area has been fenced off. A welfare and storage area has been set up to provide facilities to the staff on site, storage for machinery and a place to park vehicles.

Work has started on;

- Building of the hibernacula (places where reptiles can go in the winter) and reptile basking banks.
- Building a wildlife pond
- Creating a reptile egg laying unit.

Once this has been completed work will start on ploughing and planting of grass seed.

How will this affect me?

There will be a small number of HGV movements on local roads, particularly around the site being set up and when work finishes. The contractor will be closely monitoring any mud on the roads around the site and will take actions to keep your roads clean.


