7.9. To analyse the annual playground inspection report

The Inspection Report was noted, it was agreed to replace the wooden slats as indicated in the report.

7.10. To review the results of the Best Kept Village Competition

The Parish Council was disappointed not to maintain the Best Kept Village status, however noted that the competition was high. It was recognised that to maintain standards more volunteers would be needed. Cllr Patrick agreed to contact Amersham Town Council to ask about their volunteers.
